We have now received the Search Report on the above case and

The Search Examiner considers that the most relevant document is GB-2241747A in the name of Goodden. From a brief review of the drawings of the Goodden specification it does appear that his turbine is extremely similar to the arrangement which you propose and that it will be difficult for us to obtain patent protection for your invention in the light of this prior art.

If however you decide that you wish to proceed with the application at least to the stage of publication then all that remains is for us to file an Abstract of the invention which should be filed in the Patent Office by the 30th March 1993. The application will then go to publication on or




